THREE TRAVEL GRANTS AWARDED ANNUALLY



The Center for Archival Collections (CAC), one of the Special Collections units in the University Libraries at BGSU, offers annually up to three competitive Research Travel Grants to support researchers who plan to spend at least five full working days using collections held by the CAC. The award is intended to promote and support original scholarly or creative work and to defray the costs of travel to and residence in Bowling Green, not to exceed \$1,500 per award.

Anyone - including but not limited to faculty, students, public historians, visual and performing artists, and independent researchers - who wishes to pursue a Research Travel Grant may apply, regardless of academic status or affiliation. All applicants must be over the age of 18; reside beyond a 100-mile radius of Bowling Green, OH; and may not be current BGSU students or employees.
