

Training Services Specialist

Rocky River Public Library is seeking a part-time Training Services Specialist, a training position in an independent medium-sized public library in suburban Cleveland, Ohio; approximately 21,000 population; budget approximately 5.1 million. The Training Department offers the community a resource for outstanding training programs to keep up with the constantly changing information world.

Under general supervision, the Training Specialist develops and creates training programs, documents, and materials to meet public technology training objectives and works to identify training needs and evaluate training effectiveness. Strong organizational skills and ability to work collaboratively with other staff are necessary. Schedule includes some evenings, Saturdays, and Sundays. Bachelor's degree. Completion of multiple computer classes or extensive personal experience with required applications and hardware. Minimum two years' classroom experience teaching adults *preferred*. Prior work experience in a library environment is *preferred*. Candidates should be good listeners and communicators, present an up-beat attitude, and place top priority on customer service.
