

## Getting a new "G-" tracking code for your library's website


- Log into your library's account at <a href="https://analytics.google.com">https://analytics.google.com</a>. OPLIN does not have these credentials; Google analytics accounts are set up by individual libraries.
- 2. Click the gear icon on the bottom left to get the Admin option.




3. Choose the property (website) from the drop-down list that you want to create the new GA4 code for.




## 4. Choose GA4 Setup Assistant.




## 5. Click Get started.




6. Click **Create property**. If your library has set up specific customizations for a website previously, you may wish to look at this option more closely.




7. Click See your GA4 property.



8. Click the arrow to the right of Tag installation.



9. Under **Data streams**, click the arrow to the right of the website property you want to see.



10. Under "Web stream details," copy and paste the measurement ID number. It starts with "G-." You will note that there are other IDs associated with each property, including the original GA code, which starts with "UA-." Those other IDs are not what is needed for the new GA4 tracking.
