


## Using the Editoria 11y Full Report Feature


You can now see all of your Webkit's Editoria11y accessibility errors in one location!

Once the new full report feature is installed to your library's
Webkit, you'll notice that the Editoria11y button icons have
changed. There will be a new one to the far left and, when
moused over, you'll see the text "Open site reports in new tab." \*




\*Opening links in new tabs or windows for the public should be completely avoided. This is opening in a new tab to allow you to keep the report up and running while you work on the site, as a site administrator.

2. In the new tab, you'll be able to see the full report. It prioritizes the top issues and also shows you a list of pages that have the most issues that need to be remediated.



3. If you click on one of the items in the "Top Issues" list, you'll see something like the screenshot below. You can then click on a listed item to go directly to the content that contains the error(s), where you can use the regular "Edit" tab to make the changes. Same for clicking an item in the "Pages with the most issues" on the front page of the report.
