## Finding matching bibliographic records

---

The 2 most important factors in determining matching bibliographic records are **FORMAT** and **CONTENT**. Different formats require separate bib records. Conducting a **GENERAL KEYWORD** search is the recommended search method in both the SEO catalog and CatExpress. **BROWSE** type searching is not recommended because items in certain non-circulating statuses negatively affect the results.

### ▪ Other formats found in the SEO catalog are:

- Compact disc + book combination of equal importance [CD/book]
- Cassette tape + book combination of equal importance [cassette/book]
- DVD + book combination of equal importance [DVD/book]
- Combination of 3 or more formats [kit]
- Other physical materials [realia]

### ✓ Content that **MUST MATCH** includes:

- ✓ Author(s)
- ✓ Title
- ✓ Subtitle (except "a novel")
- ✓ Illustrator(s)
- ✓ Adapted by statements
- ✓ Edition statements that refer to content (e.g. 2<sup>nd</sup> ed, revised ed.)

### ⊗ Content that is **NOT required to match** includes:

- ⊗ ISBN, UPC and/or other standard number(s)
- ⊗ Edition statements that do not refer to content (e.g. Scholastic ed.)
- ⊗ Publisher(s) and/or distributor(s)
- ⊗ Publication date
- ⊗ Number of pages
- ⊗ Series
